GENERAL INFORMATION



AIR TAXI SERVICE: This service to off-line points is available at many cities served by NWA. BAGGAGE: "baggage" includes all baggage, such as brief cases, packages, typewriters, camera equipment and similar articles, whether carried in the cabin, or checked prior to boarding. Free baggage allowance and excess charges are as follows: When traveling first class or business class, 100 lbs. (45 kg.) per passenger. When traveling in economy class, 50 lbs. (22.5 kg.) per passenger. The Continental U.S. excess charges are 75¢ per pound of the adult first class pro-rata rate. (3) 60 lbs. first class, 44 lbs. tourist between certain U.S. cities and Canada; excess charges are 75¢ per pound of the adult first class pro-rata rate. (4) 60 lbs. first class, 44 lbs. tourist on all travel within the Orient, to or from the Orient, to or from Hawaii and to or from Alaska (except between Seattle and Portland and Anchorage). (5) 60 lbs. first class, 44 lbs. tourist on all travel between Seattle and Portland and Anchorage. Special rates are available for golf bags between certain points in the U.S. and to or from the Orient. Northwest's liability for baggage will not exceed \$100 per passenger traveling in the Orient, when the Orient is 2000 air passenger fares within the U.S. and Canada, or to and from Hawaii or Alaska. You may declare a higher valuation and pay a slight additional charge.

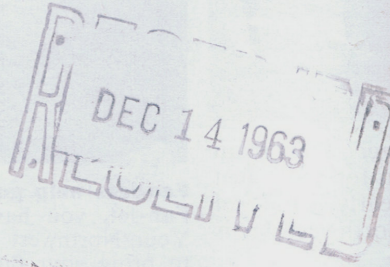
