# GENERAL INFORMATION



**AIR TAXI SERVICE:** This service to off-line points is available at many cities served by NWA.

**BAGGAGE:** "Baggage" includes all luggage, such as brief cases, packages, typewriters, camera equipment and similar articles, whether carried in the cabin, or checked direct to destination. Free baggage allowance and excess charges are: (1) 50 lbs. when traveling first class or tourist airway within the Continental U.S.; excess charges are 1/2¢ per pound of the adult first class pro-rata fare. (2) 65 lbs. for first class, 45 lbs. for tourist airway within the U.S., or from the U.S. to Alaska, Hawaii and to the Hawaiian Islands. (3) 65 lbs. for tourist airway between Hawaii and the U.S. (4) 65 lbs. for Alaska; excess charges are 1/2¢ per lb. of the applicable adult fare. Minimum charge is 50¢. (5) Excess rates are available for 400 lbs. weight and average when traveling to or from Anchorage; excess charges are 1/2¢ per lb. of the applicable adult fare. Minimum charge is 50¢. (6) Excess rates are available for 400 lbs. weight and average when traveling to or from Seattle, Portland, Fairbanks, Anchorage, or within the Orient, or \$250 per passenger traveling within the U.S. and Canada, or to and from Hawaii or Alaska. You may declare a higher valuation and pay a slight additional charge.

**CAR RENTAL SERVICE:** Automobiles are available for rental at practically all cities served by Northwest (see rental listing in the table of NWA offices in this folder). When making reservations you may request your Northwest agent to arrange that a car be waiting for you on arrival.

**CHECK-IN TIME:** Passengers are requested to be at airport ticket counter at least 20 minutes before scheduled departure of domestic flights and at least 45 minutes before departure of international flights. Passengers arriving at baggage gate less than 10 minutes before scheduled departure time will be released pending if boarding will delay flight.

**CHILDREN'S FARES:** (a) One child under 2 years, not occupying a seat or berth and accompanied by an adult, may travel free on domestic flights within the U.S. and Canada, or to Alaska. On enroute to Hawaii or the Orient, 10% of the adult fare is charged. (b) Children over 2 years occupying a seat, and child 12 years, when accompanied by an adult, are charged 75% of the adult fare. (c) Infants under 2 years may be accompanied by an adult. (d) Children between 12 to 22 years may be entitled to a discount traveling under family plan.

**SPECIAL FARES:** For groups and for excursion travel are available between many points on NWA's domestic and international routes. Contact your Northwest office for details.

**FAMILY PLAN:** First Class and Tourist Family Plan discounts are available from most Northwest cities in continental U.S.A. and Canada for spouse and children of head of family purchasing one-way full fare tickets on NWA. For amount of discount and applicable days of the week, consult your Travel Agent or Northwest Airlines office.
