For your convenience, we have enclosed the following important information. Have a pleasant trip!

Photo Identification

Required for all passengers. Boarding may be denied and ticket forfeited if passenger's identification does not match the name on the ticket.

Cancellation of Reservations

Reservations are subject to cancellation and passengers may not be eligible for denied boarding compensation if passengers have not presented themselves at the boarding point at least: 1) 15 minutes prior to scheduled departure time of domestic flights; 2) 30 minutes prior to scheduled departure time of flights to and

from Canada, Mexico, Hawaii and the Caribbean; or 3) 60 minutes prior to scheduled departure time of all other international departures and Puerto Rico.

Cancellation of Seat

Assignments
To retain their assigned seat, passengers with Advance Seat Requests must be either on board the aircraft or present themselves at least: 1) 15 minutes prior to scheduled departure time of domestic flights; 2) 30 minutes prior to scheduled departure time of flights to and from Canada, Mexico, Hawaii and the Caribbean;

3) 60 minutes prior to scheduled departure time for all other international flights and Puerto Rico.

Cancellation of Space

If you do not check in for your flights or do not board flights for which you have checked in, we will assume you will not be using any other flight segments in your itinerary, and they will be canceled.

Partner Airline Flights

If your journey begins with a Northwest Airlines flight number 2000-9999, please check in with our partner (the operating airline).

Reconfirmation

Northwest Airlines and KLM do not require reconfirmation. For other flights operated by other carriers, please check with that airline for its reconfirmation requirements.

Luggage Acceptance Times

Northwest Airlines is not liable for any expenses incurred if passengers do not check in their luggage:

U.S., Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean;

30 minutes prior to departure.

International:

60 minutes prior to departure.

Carry-on Luggage

- Must fit under the seat or in an overhead compartment.
- Maximum size is 9" x 14" x 22".
- Maximum weight is 40 pounds.
- Each passenger is allowed 1 piece of carry-on luggage plus a purse or briefcase or laptop computer.
- All items not needed in flight should be checked.

• Medicine, keys, important papers and travel documents (such as passports) should be carried on board by the passenger.

• Northwest Airlines reserves the right to restrict carry-on luggage.

Free Luggage Allowance

On domestic flights (including Canada, Mexico and the Caribbean), each ticketed passenger is allowed a total of 3 pieces of luggage free of charge (2 checked and 1 carry-on). On international flights to/from U.S., each ticketed passenger is permitted a maximum of 2 pieces checked and 1 carry-on.

International interport luggage allowance is based on weight rather than number of pieces. Additional restrictions may apply and specific information is available upon request.
