IMPORTANT NOTICES

- Passengers are requested to be at the airport at least 45 minutes before flight time to complete check-in procedures. Reservations are subject to cancellation and passengers may not be eligible for denied boarding compensation unless they present themselves and receive a boarding pass at the ticket-lift point at least 10 minutes (30 minutes international) prior to scheduled departure time.
- Reconfirmation of return or continuing space is required at least 72 hours before departure from Grand Cayman, or 24 hours from Mexico. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of all remaining confirmed reservations.
- Non-smoking seating is available to passengers who meet Republic's 10-minute check-in requirements. Cigarette smoking only permitted in designated areas on our aircraft.
- Fares collected are based on the applicable rate in effect on the day of ticket purchase. Fares are guaranteed only after a ticket has been purchased. Passengers may be charged an additional amount if the itinerary and/or dates of travel are changed at the passenger's request.
- Schedules are subject to change without notice and times shown in Republic timetables or elsewhere are not guaranteed.
- Amenities such as hotel accommodations, meals, phone calls and ground transportation are not provided at Republic's expense when a flight is delayed, canceled or the passenger misconnects. If a flight is diverted to a point not shown on the passenger's ticket, only hotel accommodations are provided by Republic when warranted.
- An administrative service charge may be deducted from the actual value of any wholly unused ticket presented to Republic for refund.

NOTICE—OVERBOOKING OF FLIGHTS

Airline flights may be overbooked, and there is a slight chance that a seat will not be available on a flight for which a person has a confirmed reservation. If the flight is overbooked, no one will be denied a seat until airline personnel first ask for volunteers willing to give up their reservation in exchange for a payment of the airline's choosing. If there are not enough volunteers the airline will deny boarding to other persons in accordance with its particular boarding priority. With few exceptions, persons denied boarding involuntarily are entitled to compensation. The complete rules for the payment of compensation and each airline's boarding priorities are available at all airport ticket counter and boarding locations. *Some airlines do not apply these consumer protections to travel from some foreign countries, although other consumer protections may be available. Check with your airline or your travel agent.*

BAGGAGE

- FAA regulations require that all articles carried on board commercial aircraft will be searched.
- Carry-on articles must be limited to maximum dimension of 21" x 16" x 8" so they can be placed under the seat.
- Regulations require identification on the outside of all checked luggage. It is recommended that name, address and telephone number also be placed in the inside of each bag.
- Don't place jewelry, money, important documents, car keys or medicine in checked luggage. Fragile or perishable articles are accepted as checked baggage only at passenger's own risk.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

- Federal regulations restrict carriage on aircraft of items classified as hazardous materials. These materials include but are not limited to flammable gases, liquids and solids; non-flammable compressed gas; explosives; poisons; corrosives; oxidizing materials; radioactive materials; etiologic agents and magnetic materials. These materials and others may not be included in carry-on baggage. Violators are subject to substantial fines. Further information is available upon request.
