CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE—Your ticket is subject to the general conditions of carriage of the International Air Transport Association and to the tariff regulations of KLM Royal Dutch Airlines. For full text contact any KLM office.
VALIDITY OF TICKETS—12 months from date of issue, unless otherwise specified.
TIMES—All times indicated are local times.
CHILDREN—Children who have reached their 2nd birthday, but not their 12th, can travel at 50% of the applicable adult fare.
INFANTS—Infants under 2 years of age can travel at 10% of the applicable adult fare on all KLM services (but free when travelling locally between Miami, Havana and Kingston) provided (1) they do not occupy an individual seat and (2) only one infant is accompanied by an adult in each party.

GROUP TRAVEL DISCOUNTS—Available year-round in Economy Class, for qualified groups of 25 or more travelling together. No weekend restrictions in winter season.
MIGRANT FARES—Between October 15 and July 15 European migrants (except Italy and Greece) (Passports) can travel at 75% of the normal one-way Economy Class fare for business class (except Italy and Greece) to New York or Montreal.
