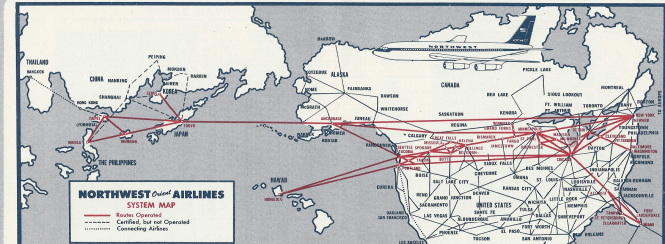

**NOTE: RESERVATIONS:** Your Northwest agent will be happy to assist you in making hotel reservations at any city on our international system.

**INCLUSIVE TOURS:** All-expense Northwest Air Vacations are available to many domestic and international cities. Consult your Northwest office or your travel agent for complete details.

**PETS:** Substantially confined pets may be carried in the cargo compartment on DC-8, Jet-Pro and jetliner flights. Contact your Northwest office for arrangements.

**RECONFIRMATION:** You must reconfirm at least 48 hours prior to departure for a return or continuing reservation on flights from office in Honolulu, on flights between Seattle and Anchorage and on nonstop flights between New York, Chicago and Anchorage. Return or continuing reservations on trans-Pacific flights between U.S. and Japan may also be reconfirmed at least 72 hours prior to departure and from Honolulu to Continental U.S. at least 48 hours prior to departure. For all other return and continuing reservations on Northwest we suggest you call our reservation office at the boarding point of your return or continuing flight and leave a telephone number where you may be reached.

**RESERVATIONS:** You may obtain reservations for any flight by telephone, wiring, or writing any Northwest Airlines office, a travel agent, or local transportation desk. Reservations are tentative and tickets are not issued until you have confirmed your reservation. Reservations are not to be advanced as possible to that other passengers can be accommodated.

**RESPONSIBILITY FOR DEPARTURES, ARRIVALS AND CONNECTIONS:** Northwest is not responsible for failure of airport to depart or arrive on scheduled time, or failure to make connections with other flights.

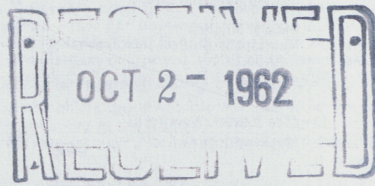

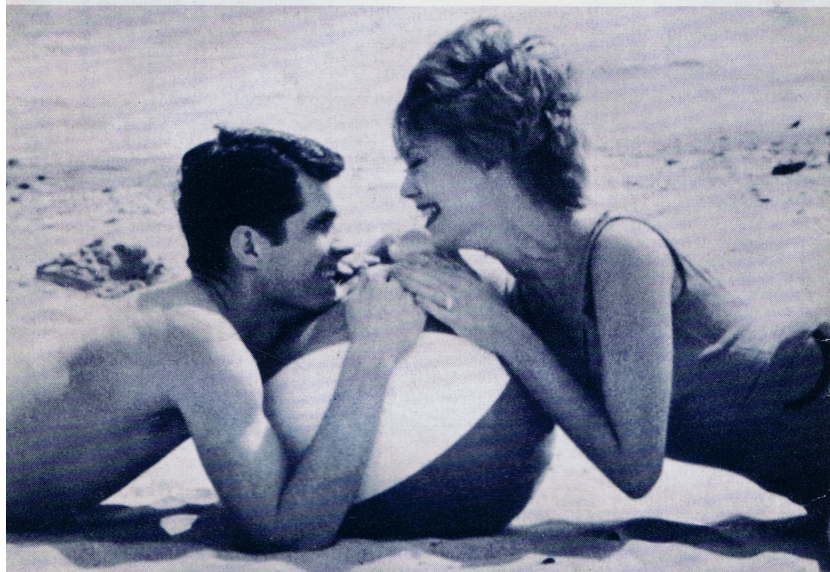
