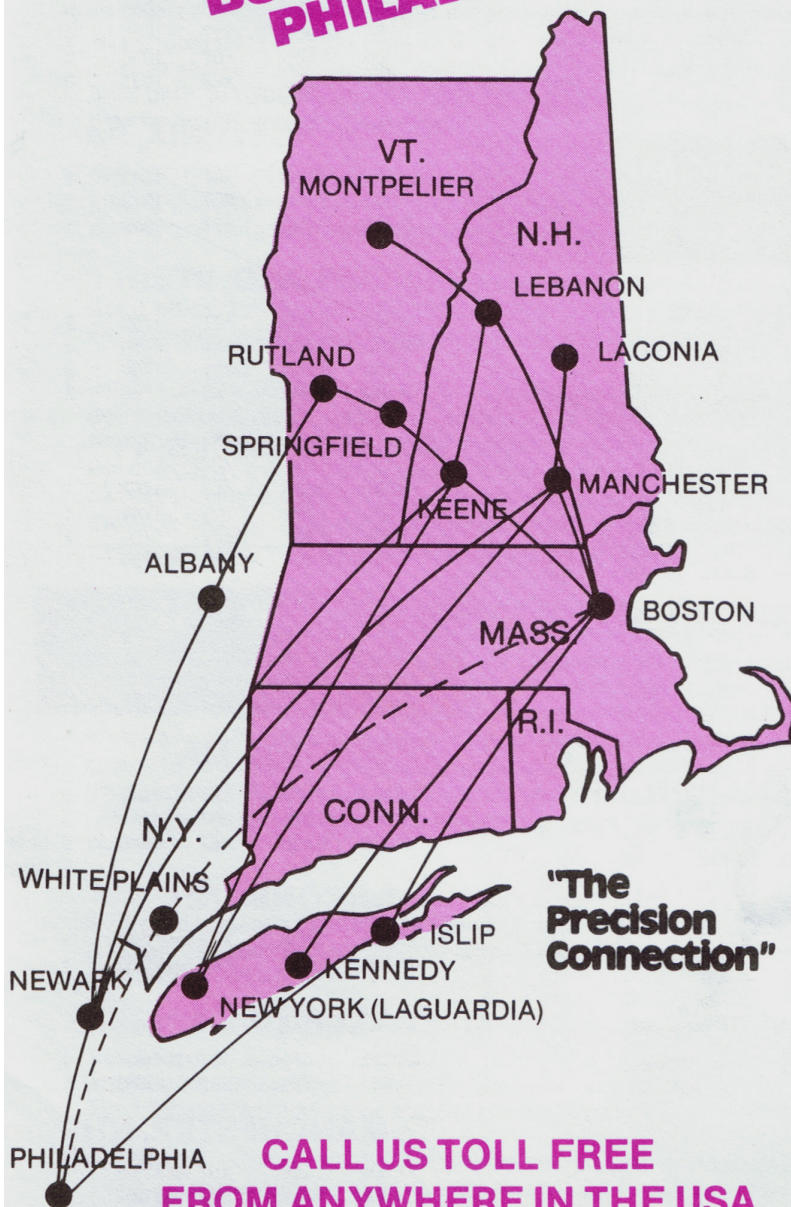

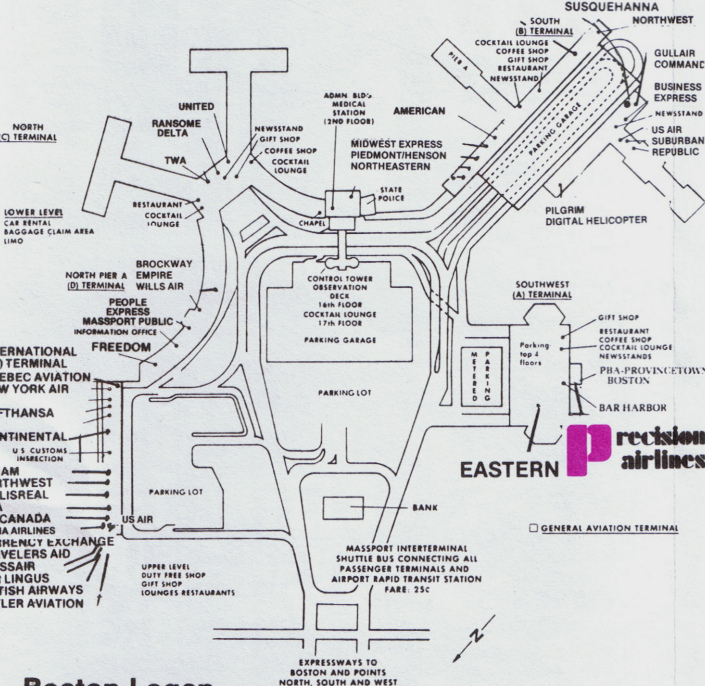
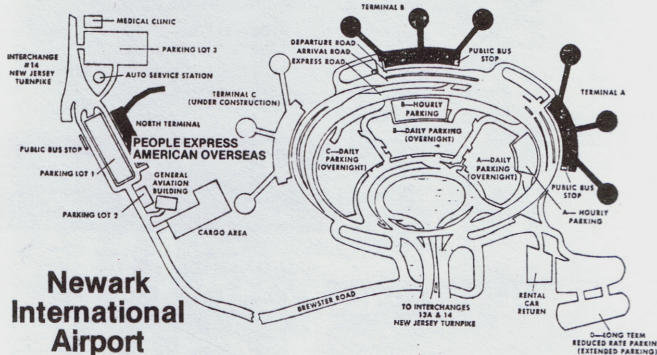

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

FARES - All fares include the applicable Federal Transportation Tax and are subject to change without notice.

CREDIT CARDS - Universal Air Travel Card, American Express, VISA, Master Charge, and Diners Club are acceptable for travel within the Precision route system and may be used for all interline ticketing.

CHILDREN - One child under 2 years old, when not occupying a seat, may be carried free with each fare paying adult passenger. Children 2-11 inclusive are carried at 75% of the adult fare when accompanied by a full fare adult for local or joint fare travel.

RESERVATIONS - Precision Airlines is a host of the **EASTERN AIRLINES** computerized reservation system. Reservations should be made as far in advance as possible. Call toll free Precision Airlines 1-800-451-4221 or contact a certified carrier or a local travel agent. Due to limited number of seats available, passengers unable to use reservations are requested to cancel as soon as possible.

RECONFIRMATION - All reservations must be reconfirmed prior to day of travel.

AIRPORT CHECK-IN - Unticketed passengers reservations will be held until 30 minutes prior to flight time, at which time, if still unclaimed, they may be sold to standby passengers. Reservations for ticketed passengers will be held until 10 minutes prior to flight time, at which time, if unclaimed, they may be sold to standby passengers.

OVERBOOKING - Precision Airlines overbooks certain flights due to the recurring passenger "no show" problem. Under certain conditions, passengers denied boarding may be entitled to some compensation.

REFUNDS - Tickets purchased by credit card may be refunded at any Precision ticket office. Tickets purchased by any other form of payment may be refunded by writing or appearing at the general office of Precision Airlines.

CANCELLATION BY THE COMPANY - The company reserves the right to cancel, terminate, divert, postpone, or delay any flight either prior to departure or enroute. The right to substitute equipment at any time is also reserved by the company. It shall be the policy of this company to notify passengers of cancellation of a flight as far in advance as possible and to do our best to assist in making other arrangements. In the event of such cancellation, the passenger's sole recourse shall be recovery of the fare.

BAGGAGE - The maximum free baggage allowance is (2) pieces with a total weight not to exceed 50 pounds per passenger. One piece with linear dimensions (length & width & height) not exceeding 55 inches and one piece not exceeding 45 inches. A third piece may be carried on board and stowed under passenger seat or designated compartment. Military personnel may check one duffel, sew or B-4 bag in lieu of 1st and 2nd piece. Baggage in excess of free allowance will be transported when space is available at an extra charge of \$6.00 per piece. Snow or water skis, scuba equipment and golf bags will be charged \$6.00 excess per piece regardless of the number checked.

BAGGAGE LIABILITY - Limited to \$250 per checked article for a maximum of \$500 per fare paying passenger traveling within the Precision route system. A higher limit per fare paying passenger is provided when interline ticketed with another air carrier.

ANIMALS - Pets or animals may not be carried on Navajo aircraft. They must be carried in approved containers, within the luggage compartment, and shall be assessed an air freight charge. Animals will not be carried November 1 through April 15 except on Dornier 228 flights.

AIR FREIGHT - Carried on all flights where weight and space permits. Connections are made directly to all airlines and freight forwarders. Freight carried on passenger flights is limited to 100 pounds per piece. Shipments in excess of 100 pounds will be carried on cargo flights. Ask for rates, dimensions and delivery service at any ticket office.
