IMPORTANT INFORMATION

FARES — All fares include 8% Federal Transportation tax and are subject to change without notice. The following credit cards may be used for flights within the Precision Airlines system only. American Express, Master Charge and Bank Americard. Universal Air Travel Card only may be used for through ticketing with certified carriers.

RESERVATIONS — Reservations should be made as far in advance as possible. Call toll free Precision Airlines or contact a certified carrier or a local travel agent. Due to limited number of seats available, passengers unable to use reservations are requested to cancel as soon as possible.

RECONFIRMATION — All reservations must be reconfirmed six hours before scheduled departure time and for returns or continuing space when the passenger stops for more than 12 hours.

DEPARTURES — Unticketed passengers are requested to check-in at airport ticket counter 30 minutes before published departure time. Passengers holding tickets are requested to check-in 20 minutes before flight time. Reservations not claimed 10 minutes brior to scheduled flights are subject to cancellation.

CANCELLATION BY THE PASSENGER — Passengers may receive full retund for unused transportation, providing reservation is cancelled three business hours prior to departure. Tickets will not be honored at a later date for "noshow" passengers.

 ${\bf REFUNDS} -$ All refunds may be obtained by writing or appearing in person at the general office of the company.

CANCELLATION BY THE COMPANY — The company reserves the right to cancel, terminate, divert, postpone, or delay any flight either prior to departure or enroute. The right to substitute equipment at any time is also reserved by the company. It shall be the policy of the company to notify passengers of cancellation of a flight as fair in advance as possible and to do our best to assist in making other arrangements. In the event of such cancellation, the passenger's sole recourse shall be recovery of the fair.

BAGGAGE — The maximum free baggage allowance for a fare paying passenger will be (2) pieces, total weight not to exceed forty (40) pounds. I piece of baggage with linear dimensions (length + width + height) not exceeding 55 inches. I piece with linear dimensions not exceeding 45 inches. Military personnel may check (1) duffle, sea or B-4 bag in lieu of the 1st and 2nd piece. Sporting equipment such as skis, golf bags, etc. are included in the per piece rules. Excess baggage shall be transported when space is available at an extra charge of \$3 per piece.

BAGGAGE LIABILITY — Limited to \$100 per fare paying passenger, unless a higher valuation is declared and additional charges paid in advance at a rate of 10° per \$100. Carrier is not liable for loss, damage to or delay in the delivery of fragile or perishable articles, money, jewelry, silverware, negoliable papers, securities, or other valuables, business documents or samples or articles not suitable or suitably packed for transportation in the aircraft, which are included in the passenger's checked baggage, whether with or without the knowledge of the carrier.

ANIMALS — May not be carried aboard passenger flights, but may be shipped in approved containers as air freight aboard cargo flights.

AIR FREIGHT — Carried on all flights where weight and space permits. Connections are made directly to all carriers and forwarders, Freight carried on passenger (lights is limited to 100 pounds per pices. Shipments in excess of 100 pounds will be carried on cargo flights. Ask for rates and delivery service at any ticket office.
