RESERVATIONS must be made in advance as all seats space for which tickets have not been purchased will not be held. Reservations may be made at any Northwest Airlines' ticket office, or at any of our agents' offices, authorized by the Postal or Western Union Telegraph offices, or offices of communication. **CANCELLATIONS** will be accepted and full refund made if made before departure where planes depart after 10:00 a.m. before scheduled departure where planes depart after 10:00 a.m. served but not paid for will be held until two hours before departure and will be sold at that time if not called for. **BAGGAGE:** Forty pounds of baggage including brief case, handbag, or suitcase will be carried free on any ticket. Baggage in excess of 40 pounds will be charged for at the rate of 1% of the published rate per pound, with a minimum charge of 25 cents. Baggage in excess of 50 pounds will be carried only by special arrangement. **ROUND TRIP FARES:** Return coupons of round trip tickets for transportation only when reservations have been made.
