SCHEDULED AIRLINES

"Confirmed Ticket Pick-up Policy"



A new time limit ticketing procedure has been inaugurated by U. S. scheduled airlines designed to reduce the number of "no shows," late cancellations, and multiple reservations, and enable the airlines to give you more effective service. This plan has the approval of the Civil Aeronautics Board.

THE PLAN PROVIDES THAT—

1. A reservation will not be held unless a confirmed ticket has been picked up by 12:01 A.M. the day of departure or six hours prior to flight departure, whichever is earlier.
2. If it is inconvenient for you to purchase your ticket at one of our ticket offices you may secure your ticket by U. S. mail, telegraphic money order, ticket delivery service, or through your Travel Agent.
3. As a convenience to you, if you have a ticket for other flights but do not have confirmed reservations or, if you have a ticket and confirmed reservations but believe there may be a reason to change your plans, you may leave your ticket at the "will call" position of Northwest's airport ticket counter and receive a receipt for it. Northwest will make any necessary additions or changes to your ticket, saving you a trip to our ticket office.
4. If your plans change, remember to cancel your reservations.

With your cooperation the U. S. scheduled airlines will be able to make more seats available when you want them.

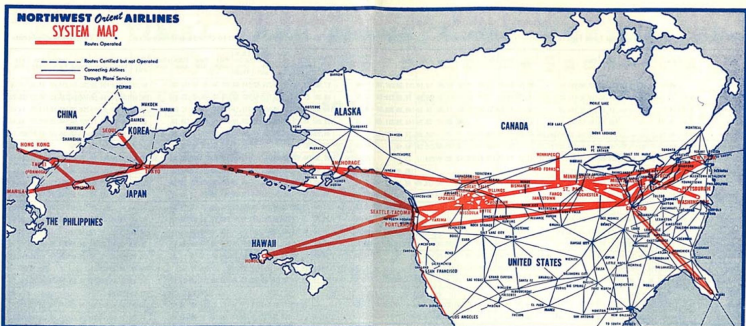

GENERAL INFORMATION

AIRLINE TRIP INSURANCE: You may purchase insurance covering your trip anywhere in North America or Hawaii at any Northwest office. Maximum insurance is \$62,500, obtainable in units of \$6,250 at a cost of \$25 per unit.

AIR TAXI SERVICE: This service is available at many cities served by NWA to off-the-point, BAGGAGE: "Baggage" includes all luggage, such as brief cases, packages, typewriters, camera equipment and similar articles, whether carried in the cabin or checked prior to boarding. Free baggage allowances are: (a) 40 lbs. when traveling first class or tourist entirely within the U.S. and Canada; (b) 44 lbs. when traveling to or from Hawaii; (c) 66 lbs. when traveling first class or tourist between Seattle and Alaska; (d) 66 lbs. first class, 44 lbs. tourist when traveling between U.S. cities and Seattle, in connection with travel to or from Alaska; (e) 66 lbs. first class or 44 lbs. tourist when traveling to, from, or within the Orient. For baggage in excess of free allowance, the charge per pound is 1% of the adult first class one-way fare, with the following exceptions: 1) Between Seattle and Anchorage, charges are 1% per kilo of the applicable one-way fare. 2) Passengers on DC-4 aircraft traveling between Okinawa-Tokyo, Okinawa-Tokyo, and Seoul-Tokyo will be charged seventy (70) cents for the first 10 lbs or fraction thereof. Minimum charge is 25c. Northwest's liability for baggage will not exceed \$100 per passenger, unless you declare a higher valuation and pay a slight additional charge.

BIRTH ACCOMMODATIONS: Berths are available on most transcontinental Stratocruiser flights, and on services to the Orient.

CAR RENTAL SERVICE: Automobiles are available for rental at practically all cities served by Northwest (see car rental listing in the table of NWA offices in this folder). When making your reservation, you may request your Northwest agent to arrange that a car be waiting for you on arrival.

CHECK-IN TIME: Passengers expect on-time performance. In your best interests, we request you report to the Northwest ticket counter at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled departure of your flight. For international flights, allow at least one hour for customs clearance. Your reservation is subject to cancellation if you do not appear at least 10 minutes prior to departure.

CHILDREN'S FARES: (a) One child under 2 years, not occupying a seat or berth and accompanied by a full-fare passenger, will be carried free on services within the U.S. and Canada, or to Alaska. On services to Hawaii or the Orient, 10% of the adult fare is charged. (b) Children under 7 years occupying a seat, and children under 12 years are charged 50% of the adult fare. (c) Infants prior to age 2 years, children under 8 years must be accompanied by an adult. (d) Children between 12 to 22 years pay full one-way fare if traveling under Family Plan.

FAMILY PLAN: With the purchase of a first-class one-way ticket for travel anywhere within the U.S. between 12:01 p. m. Mondays thru 11:59 a. m. Thursdays, you may bring additional

tickets at half price for your spouse and all children between 12-22 years of age to accompany you. One child under 2 years not occupying a seat may travel free.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION: In all cities served, Northwest has arranged with independent operators for transportation at reasonable rates between downtown areas and the airports.

HELICOPTER CONNECTIONS: If you are traveling to or from New York City, you may obtain helicopter service between International (Idlewild) Airport and many points in the New York metropolitan area. In most cases, there will be no additional charge for this service if you are traveling to or from a point west of Detroit.

HOTEL RESERVATIONS: Your Northwest agent will be happy to assist you in making hotel reservations at any city on our international system.

INCLUSIVE TOURS: All-expense Northwest "Airventures" are available to many domestic and international cities. Consult any Northwest office or your travel agent for complete details.

PETS: Suitably confined pets may be carried in the cargo compartment on all Stratocruiser flights. Contact your Northwest office for arrangements on other aircraft.

RESERVATIONS: You may obtain reservations for any flight by telephoning, wiring, or writing any Northwest Orient Airlines office, a travel agent, or hotel transportation desk. Reservations are tentative until tickets are purchased. Northwest agents will be happy to assist you with your itinerary for travel anywhere in the world. If your plans change, please cancel your reservations as far in advance of departure time as possible so that other passengers desiring transportation can be accommodated. You may make application for refund through any Northwest office.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR DEPARTURES, ARRIVALS, AND CONNECTIONS: Northwest is not responsible for failure of aircraft to depart or arrive on scheduled time, or failure to make connections with other flights.

SCHEDULES AND FARES: All schedules and fares are subject to change without notice, and Northwest is not responsible for errors thereon. Published fares do not include federal transportation taxes.

STOP-OVERS: You may stop over at any city enroute, provided your reservation is made accordingly. No additional cost is involved unless you are traveling air coach within the U.S.

TICKET VALIDITY: Your ticket is valid for one year from the date of issue, or from the date you use the first coupon.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: For international travel, you must possess valid passports, visas, certificates, or other documents as required by the countries involved. You may obtain specific information from any Northwest office.

TRAVEL FUNDS: We suggest you carry the majority of your funds in the form of Traveler's Checks, Money Orders, or Letters of Credit.

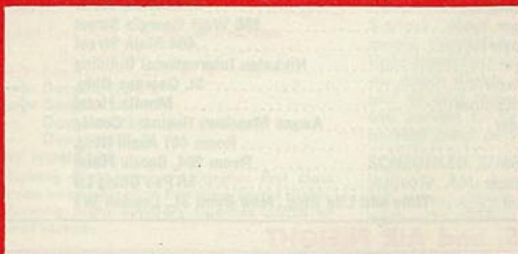
