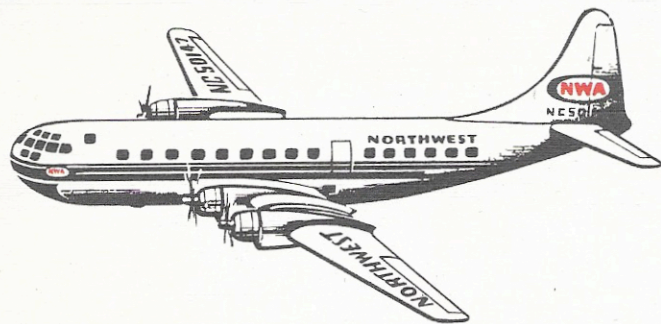

Everything we do is calculated to offer you the utmost in comfort, convenience, safety and speed.

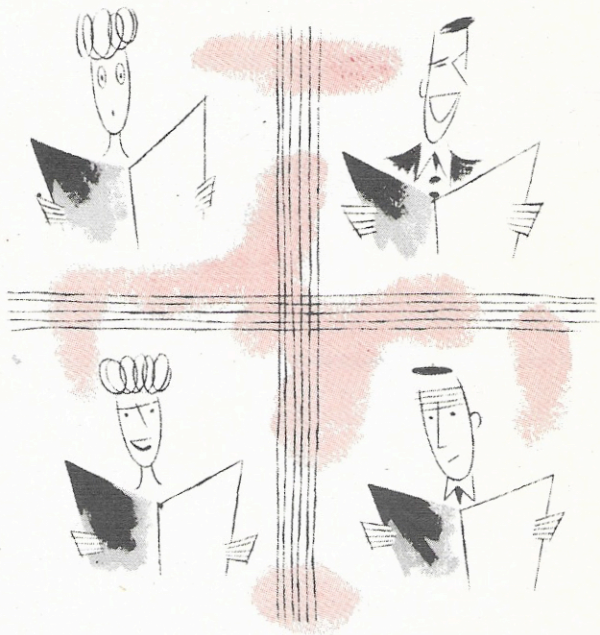

Don't be Bashful

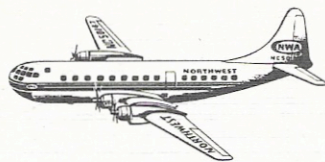

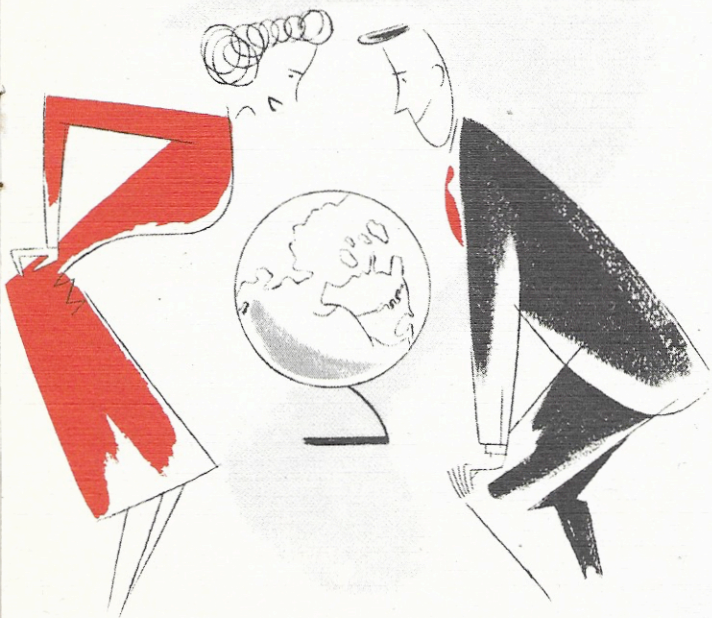
The following are a few hints to the prospective international traveller . . . the offices of Northwest Airlines will be glad to furnish more detailed information, well in advance of your contemplated trip. Please check with your Northwest Airlines traffic representative.

Restroom Conveniences

You may walk back to the fully equipped rest rooms any time after the "seat belt" light goes off. Here you will find toilet facilities and wash basins (sometimes in cold weather we must ask you to cooperate in conserving the supply of water). Sanitary chemical toilets, electric razors, mirrors, towels and soap, as well as many other extra conveniences are available. Ask the stewardess.

Stretch your Legs

Passengers are invited to disembark and look around at intermediate station stops. The stewardess will inform you about the length of time you have. Many of the fine airport terminals along the Northwest route feature restaurants, news stands, snack bars and lounge facilities.



Before You Leave

At least four weeks should be allowed for the procurement of the following documents and inoculations, required for travel to the Orient

Passport—(Allow at least four weeks to obtain)

Visas—for each country to be visited

Health Certificate—not more than 6 months old

Smallpox inoculation—within last three years (6 months for entry into Japan)

Typhus certificate—not more than 6 months old (Japan, 60 days)

Typhoid certificate—not more than one year old

Cholera certificate—within 4 months

(Typhus and typhoid are recommended but not required for entry into the Philippines)

Military Permit—for stopover in Japan, Korea, Okinawa

The above requirements are for U. S. citizens; aliens have additional requirements. Each passenger should check carefully on all current requirements before time of departure. It is recommended that twelve extra passport photographs be taken along for use en route.

Due to changing conditions, check with your Northwest Airlines representative for up-to-the-minute information.

Your Travel Funds

While currency regulations vary from country to country, it is recommended that travel funds be carried in U. S. dollar travellers' check . . . larger sums in U. S. dollar Bank letters of credit.

In Flight to the Orient

Every possible convenience is supplied to passengers aboard Northwest Flights over the "Overland" scenic route to the Orient. There's something to see all the way, with land never more than an hour off the regular course, and some of the world's most spectacular scenery below most of the time.

Cocktails are served before meals without extra charge. Snacks, fruit juices, hot chocolate, coffee, etc., available at all times. Make yourself at home and enjoy your Orient air cruise to the utmost . . . steward, stewardess and flight crew alike are at your service all the way. Ground stops offer variety, and each station is carefully equipped for convenience and comfort.

The world's finest airway stretches out below, on your Orient flight, marked by frequent airports every few hundred miles, and equipped with every type of modern navigation and communication aid.

Your Cabin Necessities

Take the things you'll need in flight into the cabin with you in a small bag or kit. Toilet articles, camera and films, extra handkerchiefs, books, or any other articles that will add to the complete enjoyment of the hours spent in the air and en route.

Ordinarily it will be impossible to reach your luggage before arrival at destination checked; therefore we recommend that you carry with you all immediate necessities for the trip.



For Tokyo Passengers

ENTRY

Baggage Declaration Form—Will be provided by the purser to be completed and submitted to the Customs Officer on arrival.

Currency—All funds must be declared. United States funds to be used for transactions of any nature must be exchanged on arrival. Various types of currency are used in Japan. The official Japanese currency is Yen. It is suggested that you contact reliable sources immediately after arrival in Japan for information as to the type of currency you will use which depends on the nature of your visit.

Entry Permit—Will be issued by an Immigration Officer in exchange for Military Permit. The Entry Permit must be surrendered on departure.

DEPARTURE

Application must be made through the Supreme Commander Allied Powers, ten (10) days prior to the anticipated date of departure. If anticipated stay is less than ten (10) days, application should be made at the earliest convenient time. A declaration must be made of all monies, negotiable instruments, legal and commercial documents to be taken from Japan.

All baggage will be subject to Customs Inspection.

GENERAL

Assistance on all matters will be gladly rendered by Northwest Airlines office located at 2 Nichome Marunouchi, Room 138, Tokyo, Japan.

Shanghai Passengers

ENTRY

Alien Passport Examination Form—will be provided by the Purser to be completed and submitted to the Immigration officer on arrival.

Baggage Declaration Form—will be provided by the Purser to be completed and submitted to the Customs officer on arrival.

Currency—All funds must be declared on the Baggage Declaration Form on arrival. Each passenger is permitted \$100.00 in United States currency or the equivalent in any other foreign currency with no restrictions as to amount in Travelers' Checks or Letter of Credit.

Health Clearance—All passengers, on arrival, must take their Health, Vaccination and Inoculation Certificate to the Chinese Customs Medical Office for Endorsement.

Photographs—Each passenger should have extra passport size photographs in his possession on arrival at Shanghai.

Police Requirements—All passengers other than Chinese nationals staying in China for more than ten days, must obtain "Foreigners Residents Certificate" from Police Department on arrival.

DEPARTURE

Exit Visa—should be obtained as soon after arrival in Shanghai as possible and in any event at least three days before date of departure.

Foreign Currency Declaration—All funds must be declared on departure on a Foreign Currency Declaration Form provided by the Customs officer.

Health Clearance—Medical Certificates will be inspected at the Airport.

GENERAL

Assistance on all matters will be gladly rendered by Northwest Airlines offices located at Metropole Hotel and Park Hotel, Shanghai.

For Manila Passengers

ENTRY

Currency—No restrictions as to the amount of United States dollars brought into the Philippines.

Photographs—Each passenger should have extra passport size photographs in his possession on arrival at Manila.

Required

- Papers—
1. Alien Report of Arrival Form—provided by purser to be completed for submission to Immigration Officer.
 2. Alien Certificate of Registration—those passengers remaining in the Philippines more than 30 days, must register at the Department of Labor, Bureau of Immigration, Manila, within 7 days after arrival.
 3. Baggage Declaration Form—provided by purser to be completed for submission to the Customs Officer on arrival.
 4. Plant Quarantine Declaration—provided by purser to be completed for submission to Plant Quarantine Officer on arrival.
 5. Funds Declaration—provided by the purser to be completed for submission to the Customs Officer on arrival.
 6. Head Tax—(\$8.00)—collectible in U. S. A. at time of issuance of ticket in exchange for receipt to be presented to Immigration Officer on arrival, from all aliens

remaining in the Philippines more than 60 days. Exceptions:

- A. Those under 16 years of age.
- B. Those with Diplomatic immunity.

DEPARTURE

Emigration Clearance—Must be secured by all passengers including Philippine Nationals, from the Bureau of Immigration, Department of Labor, Manila.

Foreign Funds Control Certificate—Must be secured in triplicate by all passengers, including Philippine Nationals, from the Department of Finance, Foreign Funds Control Office, Manila.

Tax Clearance Certificate—Must be secured by all passengers, including Philippine Nationals, from the Department of Finance, Bureau of Internal Revenue, Manila.

“To be Accomplished by Outgoing Aliens, Temporary Visitors and Transients”—must be secured by all passengers other than Philippine Nationals from the Northwest Airlines office, Manila.

GENERAL

Assistance on all matters will be gladly rendered by Northwest Airlines office located at Manila Hotel, Manila, Philippines.



FLIGHT NOTES



Returning to the U.S.A.

You may enter the U. S. at Anchorage, Alaska, Seattle or Minneapolis, St. Paul.

\$100 worth of purchases per person may be brought in duty free. Every dutiable item must be declared on forms which will be furnished you by the flight steward long enough before arrival for you to take your time in filling them out.

Complete customs instructions will also be furnished to you in flight, and Northwest Airlines personnel will offer every possible aid in making your welcome home the fitting end of an enjoyable trip.

All articles of a Philippine manufacture that you purchase in the Philippines and bring into the United States are duty free provided you obtain a "Certificate of Origin" from the Philippines Customs Office in Manila and present it to the United States Customs Officer on arrival.

The above requirements are subject to constant revision. Last-minute up-to-date information is available at any Northwest Airlines office.
