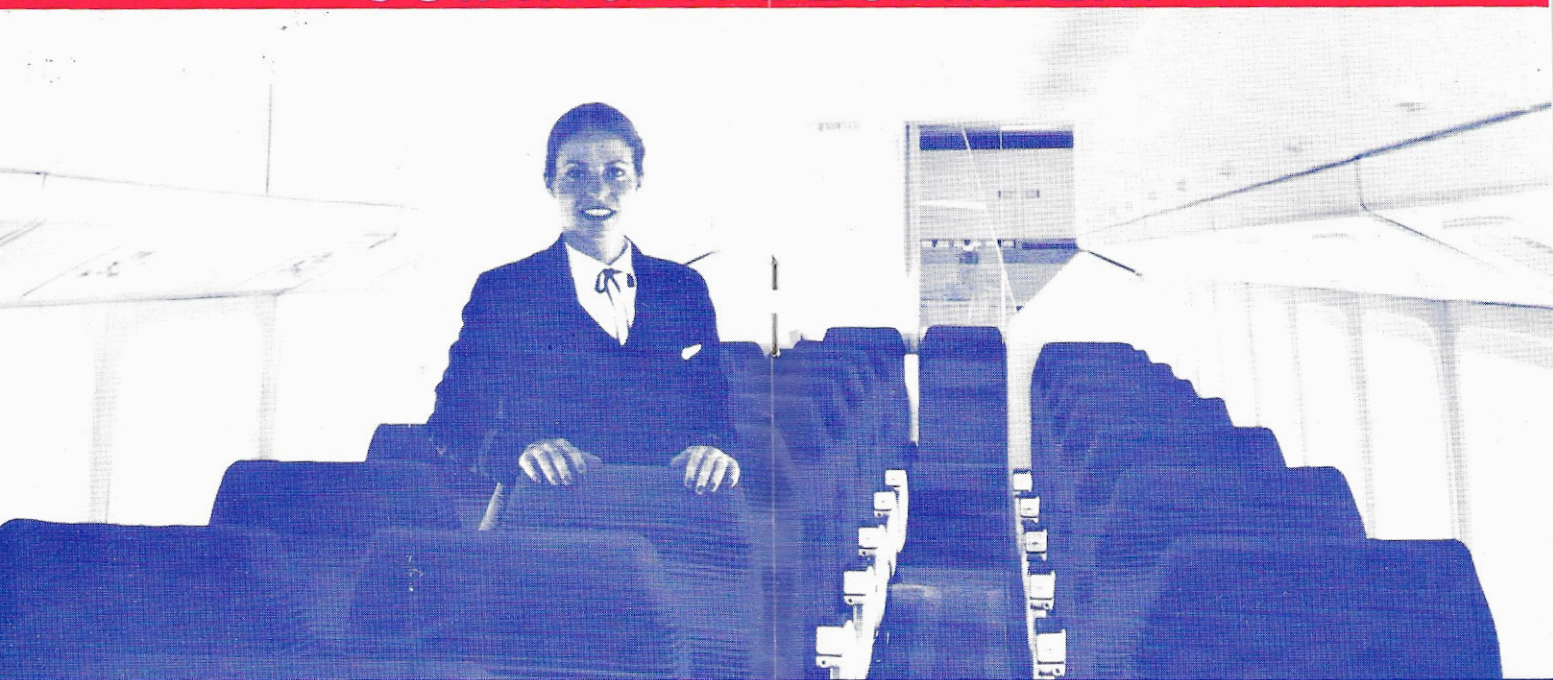

With perfect timing, the first SHORTS 360 arrives this November to celebrate the beginning of our fifth successful year of flying. Our airline began operations four years ago with two daily round trips between Marquette, in the center of Michigan's Upper Peninsula, and Lansing, the state capitol, with a six-passenger Aerostar. Over the years, more Michigan cities were added to this initial direct link between Michigan's peninsulas, building our reputation as the Michigan Connection. Presently we serve 12 cities around the Great Lakes including the metropolitan hubs of Detroit, Chicago and Milwaukee.

NEW INFLIGHT SERVICES

You, the passenger, will share in our birthday celebration as many of the features of our new SHORTS 360 will directly add to your comfort — plush individual seats, 6'6" aisles, overhead luggage compartments, lavatories, and on-board beverage service. For the first time in our history, flight attendants will welcome you aboard all 360 flights, providing for your safety and comfort.

1982 PASSENGER RECORDS

As the fifth year begins with many "firsts," our fourth year ends with the setting of many new records.

The first milestone, our 100,000th passenger boarded flight 808 July 23, 1982. Nancy Douglas from Menominee, Michigan, returning home from a morning Simmons' flight to Detroit was the lucky passenger and a perfect example of the popularity of our same-day service for northern Michigan. Our flights enable passengers to depart in the morning for a day's business and return the same evening.

The next month we set a new monthly boarding record. August was the first month we boarded over 10,000 passengers.

Having surpassed last year's boardings this summer, we look forward to celebrating a new yearly passenger boarding record this December.

A 293% increase in passenger boardings from the first quarter of 1981 to the first quarter of 1982 made us the fastest-growing regional airline in the nation according to *Air Transport World* statistics.

PASSENGER BRIEFING

FARES: Fares are to be paid in cash. Credit Cards are accepted. Children under 12 accompanied by an adult fly for a discount. We accept the tickets of all major airlines.

CHECK-IN TIME: In the interest of on-time service for all passengers, Simmons Airlines requests that all **passengers without tickets** be at the airport counter 45 minutes prior to scheduled departure time of their flight. **Ticketed passengers** should be at the airport counter 30 minutes prior to their scheduled departure time. Passengers presenting themselves at the Simmons airport counter less than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled departure time will be subject to cancellations.

BAGGAGE: For each passenger, the maximum free checked baggage allowance is two pieces with the total weight not exceeding 50 pounds. Linear dimensions (length + height + width) not to exceed 62 inches for the first piece, 45 inches for the second. Military personnel may check a duffel, sea or B-4 bag in lieu of the first and second pieces. Passenger identification labels are available from your Simmons ticket agent at no cost.

CARRY-ON LUGGAGE: Space for carry-on luggage is very limited. Any carry-on luggage remains the responsibility of the passenger. Make sure what you carry on gets carried off!

EXCESS: Baggage in excess of two checked pieces with dimensions up to 62 inches or weight up to 50 pounds shall be charged \$8.00 per piece.

OVERSIZE: Baggage exceeding the dimensions of 62 inches and up to 100 pounds shall be charged \$16.00 per piece. Baggage exceeding 80 inches or weighing more than 100 pounds per piece must be shipped by air freight or other means.

LIABILITY: Simmons Airlines baggage liability is limited to \$750 per passenger. All baggage should be locked. Do not place money, jewels, cameras, vital medication, fragile or perishable items in baggage. Due to weight limitation, there may be times when all baggage may not be accommodated on the same flight as the passenger.

CLAIMS: Damage to and loss of baggage must be reported to Simmons Airlines upon termination of your flight.

BANDEIRANTE SERVICE: All routes are served by new Embraer's Bandeirantes, a "pioneer" among the advanced-technology aircraft. Carrying 18 passengers at a cruising speed of 250 miles per hour, this twin-engine turboprop meets its schedule with uncompromised safety and fuel efficiency. Pilots are ATP rated and co-pilots are fully-certified.

RESTRICTED ARTICLES: Flammable liquids, corrosives, acids, compressed gasses, matches or other hazardous articles must not be placed in baggage. (In addition, Federal Aviation Regulations limit the carriage of compressed gasses in aerosol cans, such as hair sprays, shaving cream, and deodorant to 32 ounces per passenger with a maximum of 16 ounces per container.) "Visible Fluid" lighters may not be used on board aircraft. Operation of electronic devices is prohibited on board the aircraft due to possible interference with the navigation or communication systems. Portable electronic devices such as voice recorders, hearing aids, and heart pacemakers will be permitted.

RESPONSIBILITY: Simmons Airlines is not responsible for damage, travel expenses or overnight accommodations resulting from the failure to depart or arrive at scheduled times, not for failure to make connections, nor for cancellations beyond our control. Simmons Airlines has the right to cancel flights or reservations before passage or enroute whenever such action is advisable or necessary. The passenger will receive space on the first available flight or the unused portion of the ticket will be refunded.
