The bumping sounds you hear shortly after takeoff and as you're descending for a landing are the wheels being raised and lowered and the brakes being released. Travelers Should Plan to Arrive at the airport boarding gate at least 20 minutes

before the scheduled departure of a domestic flight and at least 40 minutes before the departure of an international flight. Under normal conditions Northwest Orient flights stay on schedule. A last-minute passenger may be refused passage if boarding will delay the flight schedule.
