

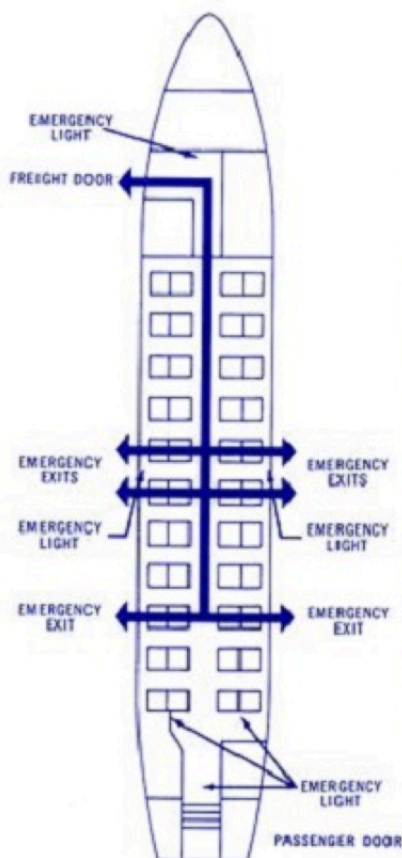
MARTIN 404

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Like all commercial airliners, the Martin 404 is equipped with special safety devices. It is extremely unlikely that these facilities will be needed, but simply as a precaution we would like you to be familiar with them. Below you will find a cabin plan of this aircraft with various exits clearly marked as well as a descriptive explanation of how to open the window exits.

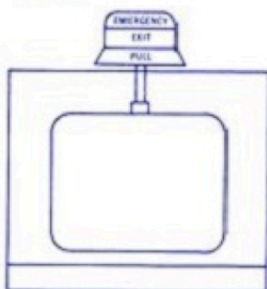

EMERGENCY EXITS



1. LOCATION

Rows 5, 6 and 9 (both sides).



2. TO OPEN

- Grasp "Pull" handle at top of exit and pull in.
- Exit falls inward.
- An escape rope, located between the fuselage and the interior lining is automatically available when the exit is opened.

In the event a non-routine landing is anticipated you will be directed to assume the position depicted in the accompanying illustration.

1) Fasten seat belt securely. 2) Place both feet together on the floor directly in front of you. 3) Lean over and rest your head on your knees. 4) Clasp hands firmly under legs. Remain in this position until the airplane comes to a complete stop.
