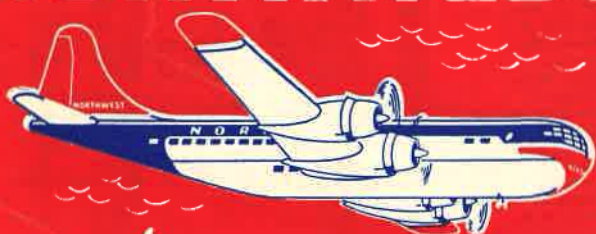

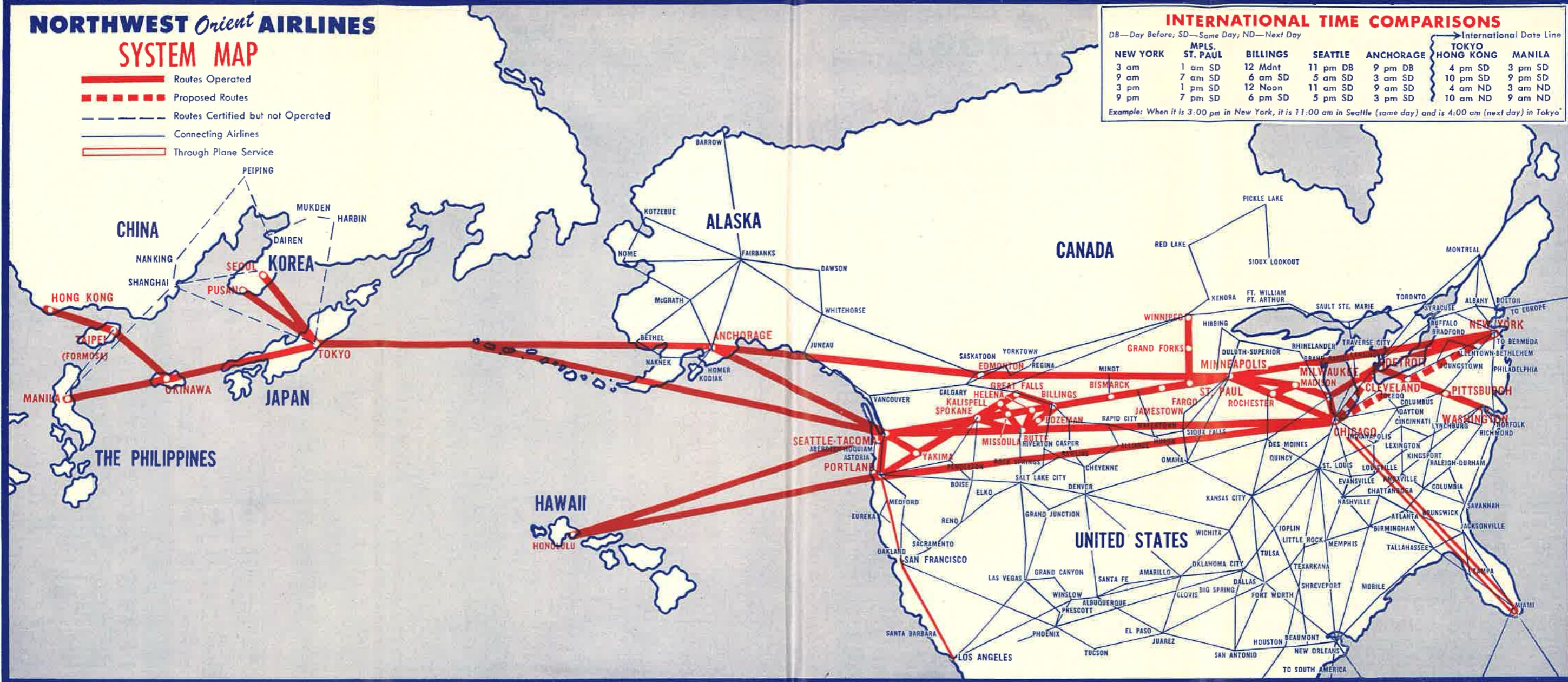

**GENERAL INFORMATION** PASSENGERS MUST CHECK IN AT AIRPORT AT LEAST TEN MINUTES BEFORE FLIGHT DEPARTURE.

All service is subject to rules and regulations contained in Tariffs on file with the Civil Aeronautics Board, copies are open for public inspection in any Northwest Orient Airlines Office. Reservations: Reservations for all flights must be made in advance.

**Ticket Validity:** Domestic and international tickets are valid for one year from date of commencement of initial flight or if no portion of the ticket is used, from the date of issuance thereof. **Children's fares:** One child under 2, not occupying seat or berth, free with each adult fare on services within U.S. and Canada and to Alaska. 10% of adult fare on services to Hawaii and Orient. Children under 2 for whom seat or berth is reserved and all children 2 and under 12 half fare.

**Half-Fare Family Plan:** With payment of one full one-way first class fare, spouse and children under 22 travel at half-fare Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays on all first class domestic flights.

**Baggage:** Includes all luggage such as brief cases, portfolios, packages and parcels, typewriters, camera equipment and similar articles, either carried in the cabin or checked. Articles such as overcoats, umbrellas and cameras will not be included in baggage weights.

**Baggage Allowance:** 40 lbs. when traveling first class or tourist within the U.S. and Canada 44 lbs. when traveling tourist to or from Hawaii. 66 lbs. when traveling first class or tourist between Seattle and Alaska and 44 lbs. tourist or 66 lbs. first class as applicable between U.S. points and Seattle in conjunction with Alaskan travel. 66 lbs. first class or 44 lbs. tourist class when traveling to or from or within the Orient. There is a charge of 1/2 of 1% of the adult first class one way fare per pound or 1% per kilo, minimum 25c for all baggage in excess of the free weight allowance.

**Baggage Valuation:** Not to exceed \$100.00 unless excess declared. Excess charges—U.S. and Canada 10c per \$100.00, limit \$2500. Elsewhere—15c per \$100.00, limit \$5000.

**Baggage Claims:** Written notice of claims arising out of loss of or damage to baggage must be filed within 45 days with an office of the carrier—action must be commenced within two years. **Stopovers:** Are permitted at most regularly scheduled stops if arrangements are made in advance.

**Schedules and Fares:** Subject to change without notice. **Taxes:** Taxes are in addition to the fares published.

**Ground Transportation:** Transportation between airports and designated pick-up points will be arranged, subject to usual charges.

**Air Taxi Service:** This service is available at many airports to off-line points at reasonable rates. Companies operating this service are members of the National Air Taxi Conference. Call any Northwest Orient Airlines office for information.

**INTERNATIONAL INFORMATION**

**Travel Documents:** Passengers must possess valid documents (passports, visas, certificates, etc.) required by the countries involved. See any Northwest Orient Airlines ticket office for this information.

**Arrival At Embarkation Points:** Passengers must arrive at designated point of embarkation in time to permit the completion of governmental and other requirements before scheduled departure.

**Responsibility for Departures, Arrivals, Connections:** Northwest Orient Airlines shall not be responsible for the failure of aircraft to depart or arrive on scheduled time or failure to make connections. Passengers are requested to be at the airport loading gate at least ten minutes before scheduled departure. Listen for the flight departure announcements. Passengers will not be paged individually by name since we cannot jeopardize the connections of all other passengers to locate one who is late.

**Holiday Cancellation:** Certain flights will be subject to cancellation on most national holidays. Consult any Northwest Orient Airlines ticket office for further information.

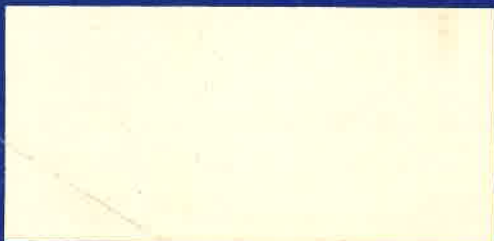
