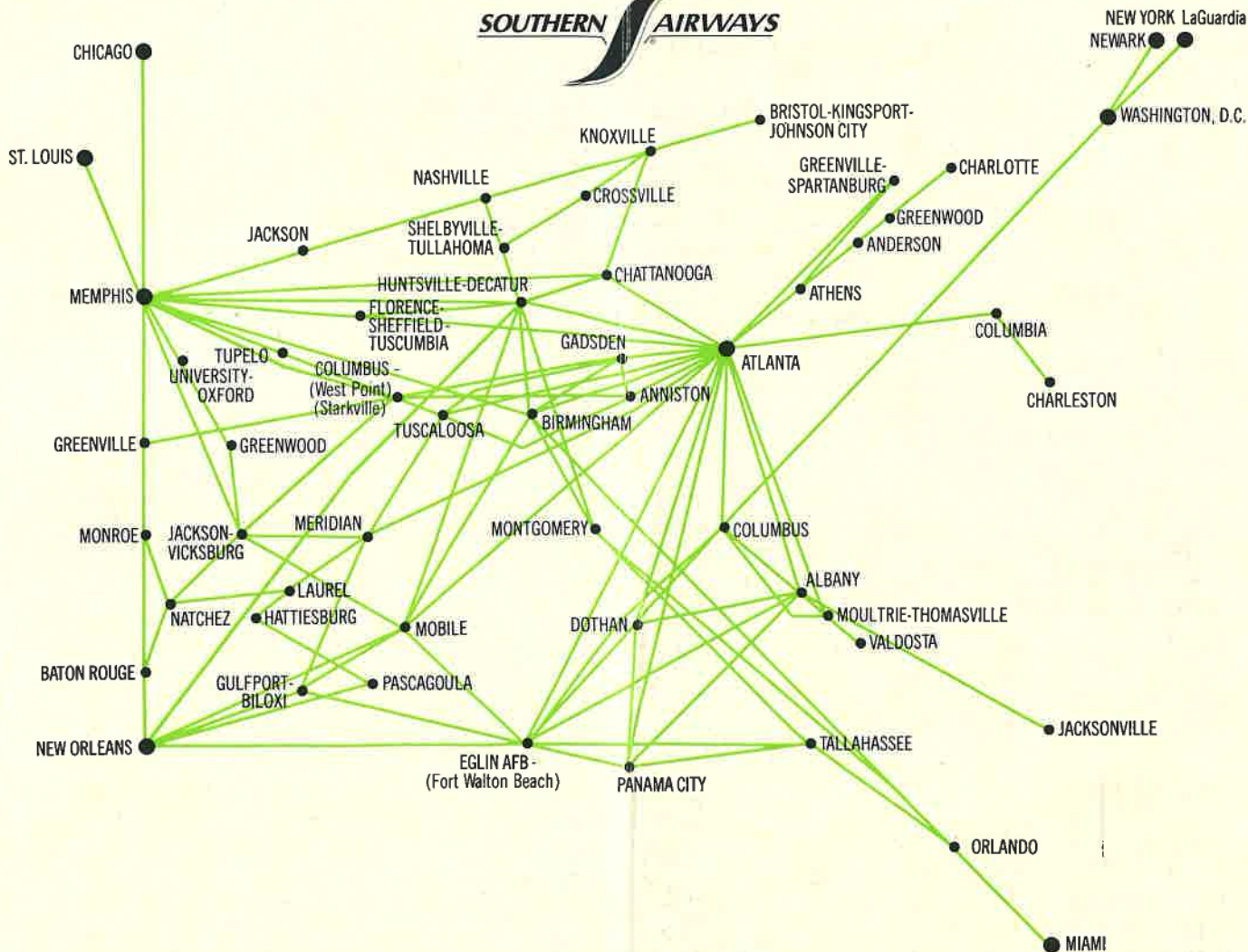

## ENJOY SOUTHERN STYLE HOSPITALITY

**FARES**—Sample fares are quoted for your convenience and are subject to applicable tariffs, which are open for inspection at any Southern Airways ticket office. Fares quoted do not include state tax, but **DO INCLUDE AN 8% FEDERAL TAX.**

**BAGGAGE**—The free baggage allowance, solely within the Continental United States and/or Canada, is three bags having linear dimensions no greater than 62", 55", and 45". Luggage in excess of the free allowance will be transported only after payment of charges in accordance with the appropriate tariff. Any piece having linear dimensions exceeding 80" or weighing more than 70 pounds will not be accepted as baggage. Government safety regulations limit carry-on baggage to items that can be stored under the passenger's seat. All passenger baggage is accepted subject to tariff limitations.

**HOTEL AND CAR RENTALS**—Reservations for hotel space and U-Drive-It automobiles may be made through any Southern office at the same time your flight space is reserved. Your Southern Agent will be happy to assist you.

**EQUIPMENT**—Flights are scheduled with 75 and 95 passenger Douglas DC-9 FanJET aircraft and 40 passenger Martin-404 aircraft.

**CHARGE ACCOUNTS**—Southern honors various major credit cards including its own Local Air Travel Plan for

travel over the routes of Southern Airways and certain trunk airlines. Your Southern Agent will be happy to furnish details.

**RESERVATIONS**—Must be made in advance at any airline ticket office or travel agency. Passengers are requested to check in at the airport ticket counter at least 20 minutes before flight departure to allow ample time for weighing baggage, checking tickets and other formalities, and to help us maintain an on-time operation of your flight. Persons may be refused passage if arriving at ticket lift position less than 10 minutes before departure time when accommodating them may delay the departure.

**RESPONSIBILITY FOR DEPARTURES—ARRIVALS—CONNECTIONS**—Southern Airways will not be responsible for damages resulting from the failure of flights to depart or arrive at times stated in this timetable, nor for failure to make connections with planes of other airlines or of this company. Schedules are subject to change without notice and are based on expected flying times. Because weather and other factors may affect operating conditions, departures and arrivals cannot be guaranteed.

**CHILDREN**—One child, under 2 and not occupying a seat, will be carried free for each passenger over 12 who pays the full adult fare. No child under 5 may travel unaccompanied under conditions outlined in appropriate tariffs.

## FAMILY PLAN.




Good for husband and wife, husband, wife and children from 12 through 21, or either parent and children 12 through 21. Head of family pays full fare, spouse (or first child if only one parent accompanies) pays 75%. Children 12 through 21 pay 2/3 and those 2 through 11 pay 50%. Fares are good anytime except from 2:00 pm to midnight on Fridays and Sundays.

## YOUTH FARES.




For those 12 through 21 with a Youth Fare I.D. Card from any domestic airline. Youths can fly in a reserved seat and save 25% of the regular fare. Good during same periods as Family Plan.

## MILITARY FARES.




Military personnel can fly in reserved seats and save 1/3 of the regular fare. Or they can fly "stand-by" and save 50%. Reserved seat fares are good during the same periods as Youth or Family Plan Fares. "Stand-by" fares are good any time.

## DISCOVER AMERICA.




Those who stay at their destination at least seven days but not more than 30 days can save up to 20% of the regular round trip fare. Good anytime except from 2:00 pm to midnight on Fridays and Sundays.

## "DOLLAR STOPOVER" PLAN
