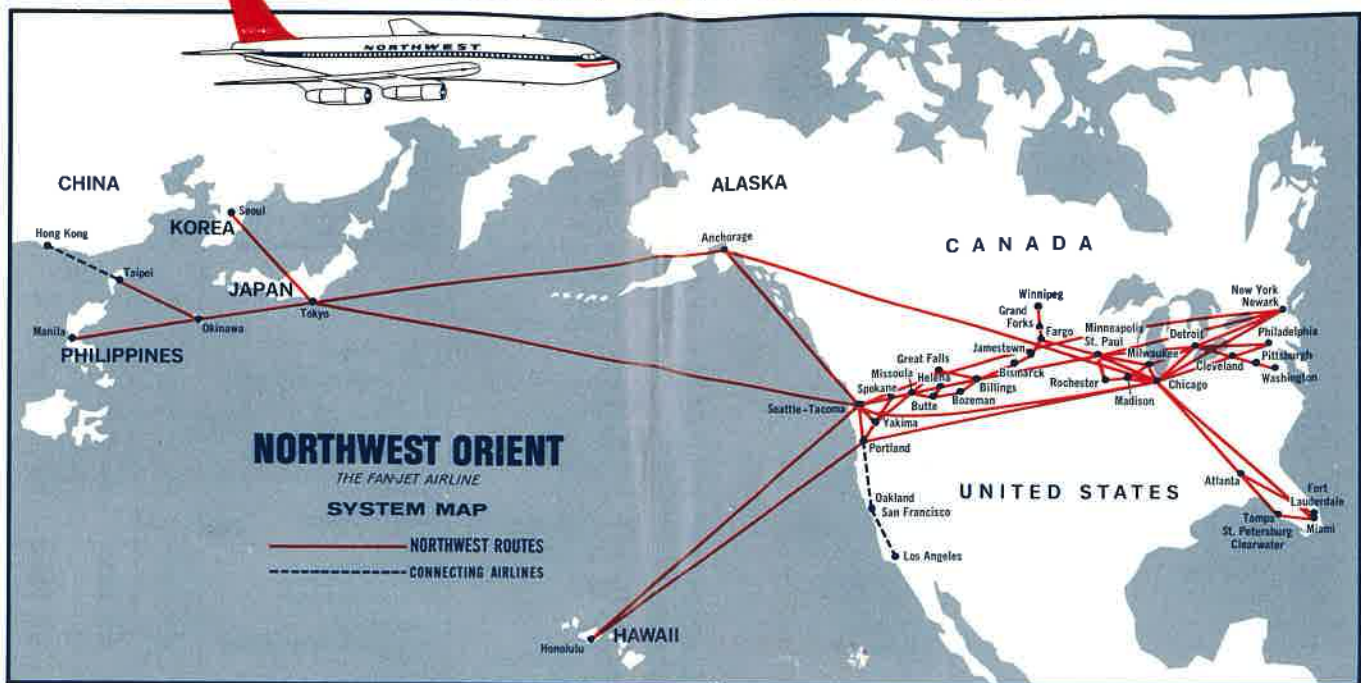

GENERAL INFORMATION



AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS: Fruits, plants, meats or similar agricultural items cannot be taken into the United States without permission. Consult the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture or the nearest U.S. Foreign office overseas for details.

AIR TAXI SERVICE: This service to off-line points is available at many cities served by NWA.

BAGGAGE: Includes all checked luggage and other articles carried by the passenger including briefcases, cameras, typewriters, etc. The domestic maximum free baggage allowance is two checked pieces of luggage and one unchecked bag retained in the passenger's custody and capable of being stowed under the passenger's seat.

EXCEPTION: Between Anchorage and Seattle or Portland, Oregon the free baggage allowance is 66 pounds for all classes of service.

The international free baggage allowance is 66 pounds for first class and 44 pounds for economy class. Contact your Northwest office for details on the acceptable maximum size of baggage and for excess baggage rates.

LIABILITY: For baggage will not exceed \$250.00 per domestic ticket and \$16.50 per kilogram of baggage per international ticket. A higher valuation may be declared for a slight additional charge. Claims must be filed within 45 days.

CAR RENTAL SERVICE: Automobiles are available for rental at practically all cities served by Northwest. When making your reservation, you may request your Northwest agent to arrange that a car be waiting for you on arrival.

CHECK-IN TIME: Passengers are requested to be at airport boarding gate at least 20 minutes before scheduled departure of domestic flights and at least 40 minutes before departure of international flights. Passengers arriving at boarding gate less than 10 minutes before scheduled departure time will be refused passage if boarding will delay flight.

CHILDREN'S FARES: (a) One child under 2 years, not occupying a seat and accompanied by a full-fare passenger, will be carried free on services within the U.S. and Canada, or to Alaska. On services to Hawaii or the Orient, 10% of the adult fare is charged. (b) Children under 2 years occupying a seat, and children under 12 years, when accompanied, are charged 50% of the adult fare. (c) Unless prior arrangement is made, children under 8 years must be accompanied by an adult. (d) Children between 12 to 22 years may be entitled to a discount if traveling under Family Plan.

SPECIAL FARES: For groups and for excursion travel are available between many points on NWA's domestic and international routes. Contact your Northwest office for details.

FAMILY PLAN: First Class and Tourist Family Plan discounts are available from most Northwest cities in Continental U.S.A. and Canada for spouse and children of head of family purchasing one-way full fare tickets on NWA. For amount of discount and applicable days of the week, consult your Travel Agent or Northwest Airlines' office.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION: In all cities served, Northwest has arranged with independent operators for transportation at reasonable rates between downtown areas and the airports. See the listing of NWA offices in this folder for fares and pickup times.

SCHEDULED HELICOPTER SERVICE: is available in Chicago on Chicago Helicopter Airways and in New York on New York Airways to and from many points in their respective Metropolitan areas. Contact your Northwest office for fares.

HOTEL RESERVATIONS: Your Northwest agent will be happy to assist you in making hotel reservations at any city on our international system.

INCLUSIVE TOURS: All-expense Northwest Air Vacations are available to many domestic and international cities. Consult any Northwest office or your travel agent for complete details.

PETS: Suitably confined pets may be carried in the cargo compartment on 320, 720B, 727, Jet-Prop and freighter flights. Contact your Northwest office for arrangements.

RECONFIRMATION: We suggest that you call the reservations office at the boarding point of every return or continuing flight and leave your local telephone number. Reservations not reconfirmed where required are subject to cancellation. Reconfirmation is required for return or continuing reservations on Northwest flights from Florida, Honolulu, Anchorage to the U.S. and from New York, Chicago or Seattle to Anchorage. Call your Northwest reservations office at least 6 hours prior to departure in Florida, New York, Chicago, Seattle and Anchorage and 48 hours prior to departure in Honolulu. In many countries reconfirmation is required 72 hours prior to departure.

RESERVATIONS: You may obtain reservations for any flight by telephoning, wiring, or writing any Northwest Orient Airlines office, a travel agent, or hotel transportation desk. Reservations are tentative until tickets are purchased. If your plans change, please cancel your reservation as far in advance as possible so that other passengers can be accommodated.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR DEPARTURES, ARRIVALS, AND CONNECTIONS: Northwest is not responsible for failure of aircraft to depart or arrive on scheduled time, or failure to make connections with other flights.

SCHEDULES AND FARES: All schedules and fares are subject to change without notice, and Northwest is not responsible for errors therein.

STOPOVERS: You may stopover at any city enroute, provided your reservation is made accordingly. For stopovers between cities within the U.S. the combination of fares over the stopover points would apply. Stopovers may be made at no additional cost when in connection with international travel.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: For international travel, you must possess valid passports, visas, certificates, or other documents as required by the countries involved. You may obtain specific information from any Northwest office.
